Pipers may enter only in 2 grades. Three competitors for all solo events. Wet weather venue: Turakina School. Events 1 & 8 will run concurrently. All pipers must report to their board stewards. All A Grade Competitors must submit three [3] tunes, B Grade & Under 21 C/ships must submit two [2] tunes. Event 20 not conducted under NZPDA rules. A deposit of \$2 per competitor number refundable on return. Refund policy—cancellation a week before the games to be in writing & refunds will be considered a week after the games.
