Dress as per rule 19. Pipers may enter only in 2 grades, except under 21 events & B Grade Piobaireachd can be additional events. Three competitors for all solo events. Wet weather venue: Turakina School. Events 7 & 9 will run concurrently. All pipers must report to their board stewards prior to each event otherwise their right to compete may be forfeited. All A Grade Competitors must submit three [3] tunes, B Grade & Under 21 C/ships must submit two [2] tunes. Events 17 and 18 not conducted under NZPDA rules. A deposit of \$2 per competitor number refundable on return. Refund policy—cancellation a week before the games to be in writing & refunds will be considered a week after the games.
